Linda Grover

Linda Grover has devoted many years to making real her children's impossible dream of creating a unifying global holiday.

Completing high school at 15, she worked as a congressional aide and caseworker for refugee children. Married to Broadway actor-singer Stanley Grover, she became an interfaith volunteer and stay-at-home mom for three exceptionally accomplished children.

Her first book, serialized in the *New York Post*, was the humorous account of her successful campaign to save the apartment building her family lived in. A *New York Times* bestseller about women's changing image followed.

As a scriptwriter and later head writer for *The Doctors*, *Search for Tomorrow* and *General Hospital*, Linda pioneered for less television violence.

In 1994 she left a high-paying career to work with schoolchildren for the global holiday her children had conceived thirty years before. The U.S. Congress unanimously passed her initiative in 2000, the UN General Assembly in 2001. Both Presidents Clinton and Bush have praised her project. She is the District of Columbia's Mother of the Year for 2002-2003 and author of the upcoming book, *This is Your Mother Speaking: The Smart Way to Fight Terror*.
